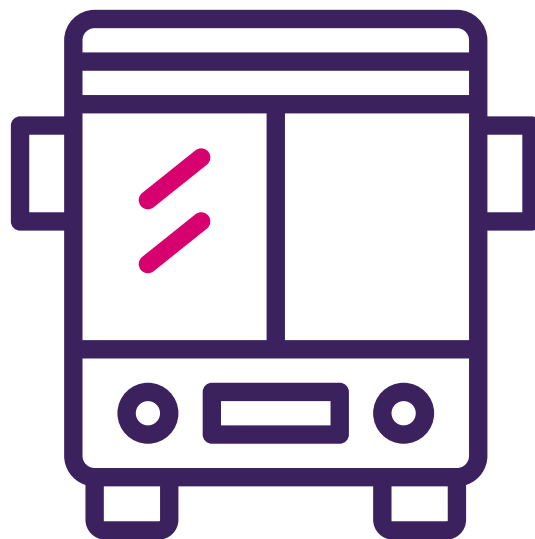




WP | Wellington Place

Travel Guide



If you commute into Wellington Place, you'll be pleased to know there are plenty of transport options. Wellington Place is located a few minutes' walk from Leeds railway station, close to various high-frequency bus routes and served by popular Park & Ride services. Not only that, but we have walking and cycling routes in and out of the city centre right on the doorstep – perfect for sustainable travel choices.

Sustainability is very important to us at Wellington Place. That's why we have invested in a variety of initiatives to support your commute, all of which are covered in this handy travel guide.

Walking and Running

Wellington Place can be accessed from Wellington Street, Northern Street and Whitehall Road. We're also close to the Leeds & Liverpool Canal towpath along Whitehall Road. The towpath is tarmacked and offers a traffic-free route into the city for walkers, runners and cyclists.

If you live within three kilometres of Wellington Place, you could walk to work in just 45 minutes. Visit [google.co.uk/maps](https://www.google.co.uk/maps) to plan your walking route to Wellington Place.



If you're interested in running and discovering new routes to and from Wellington Place then join our running club, **The Wellington Pacers**. Don't worry if you run up a sweat – there are accessible showers and changing facilities in each of the buildings at Wellington Place.

Cycling

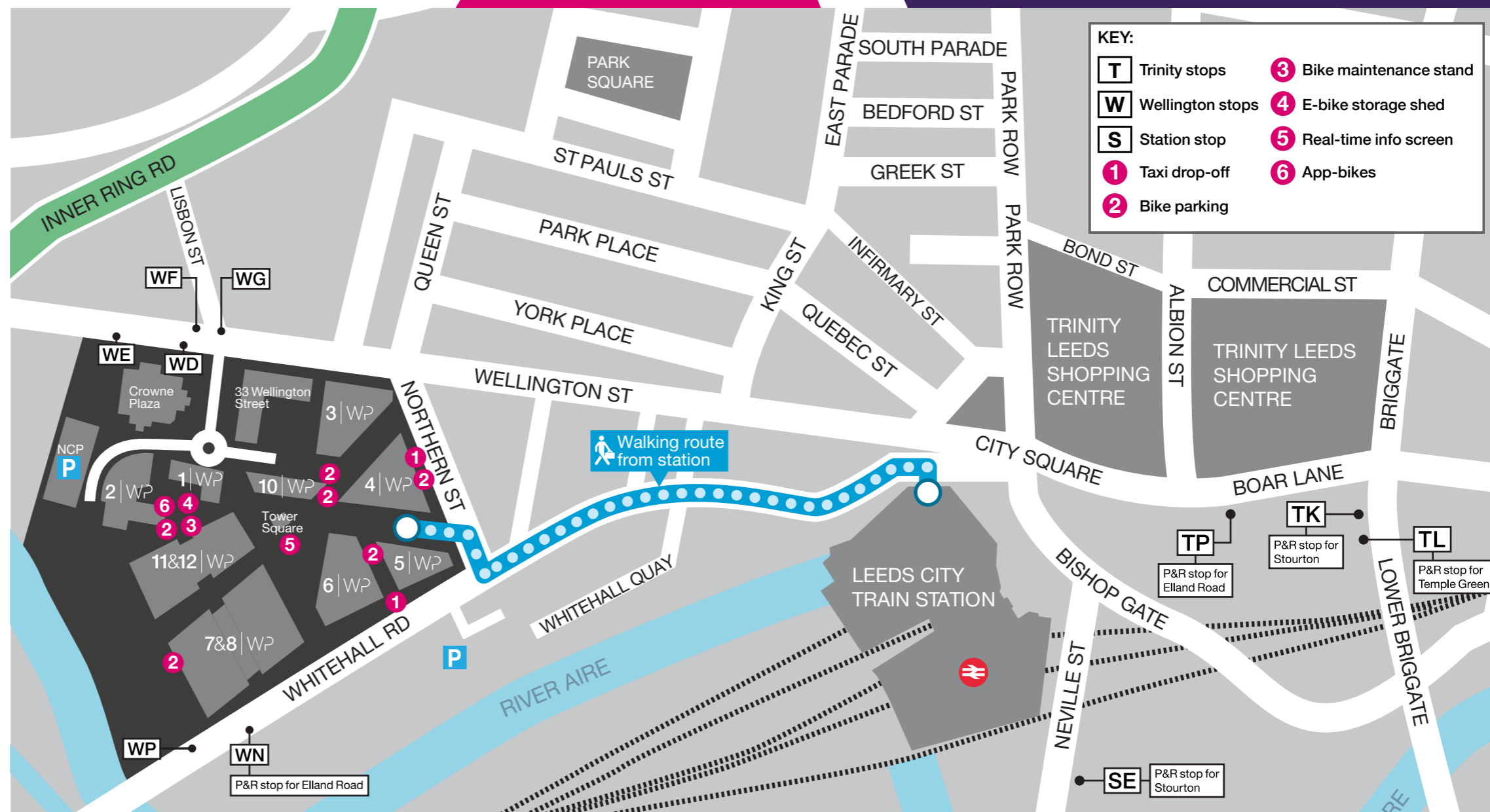
Wellington Place is extremely well connected for cyclists. We're surrounded by fantastic cycle routes in and out of the city centre including the Bradford Leeds Cycle Superhighway as well as the Leeds & Liverpool Canal towpath.

Wellington Place has been awarded the Gold Award for a Bike Friendly Business in recognition of our excellent facilities and proactive approach towards cycling. Bike facilities at Wellington Place include:

- Outdoor bike parking including CyclePods and bike racks
- Basement bike parking (except 1 and 10 Wellington Place)



- Free D-lock hire – call the security office on **07841 969 328**
- **Free bike hire** for Wellington Place occupiers
- Bike maintenance station for small **repairs**
- Free helmet hire - contact your office manager or company reception
- Accessible showers and changing facilities in each building

Wellington Place also offers free bike servicing sessions throughout the year for you to get your bike checked over. Check our [website](https://www.wellingtonplace.co.uk) for upcoming dates. Park & Ride

There are three Park & Ride sites in Leeds at Elland Road (**PR1**), Temple Green (**PR2**) and Stourton (**PR3**). Parking is safe, secure and well-lit with CCTV. There are also disabled parking spaces, EV charging, motorcycle parking and cycle spaces available.

Park & Ride tickets can be purchased at the on-site ticket machines (card only) or on board the bus (card and cash). Day tickets are £4 and parking is FREE. You can save up to 10% if you buy in bulk. £580 annual tickets are also available for **Travel Plan Network (TPN)** members.

Buses leave every 10-20 minutes and take around 15 minutes to reach the city centre. The PR1 service directly serves Wellington Place from stop Wellington N on Whitehall Road, as shown on the map. The closest bus stop for the PR2 service is stop TL on Lower Briggate, and the closest stop for the PR3 service is stop SE on Neville Street, as shown on the map. Bus

Whitehall Road and Wellington Street, either side of Wellington Place, are well served by frequent bus services between the city centre and destinations around Leeds. Many routes extend beyond the city, including to Pudsey, Bradford, Halifax and Huddersfield.

The **Leeds Core Bus Network** is a colour-coded network introduced to help users navigate local buses with ease. It's made up of 18 bus lines for services that run every 15 minutes or more. Find the map online or at most local bus stops along the **network**.

There's a real-time passenger information screen located in Tower Square to let you know the time of your next bus. Or, download our **Wellington Place App** to check live bus times. Plan your journey to Wellington Place at [wymetro.com/plan-a-journey](https://www.wymetro.com/plan-a-journey).

Rail

Leeds railway station is located a few minutes' walk from Wellington Place. You can view a walking route to Wellington Place from the station on the map.

This key transport hub offers direct services to a wide range of destinations both locally and nationally. Download our **Wellington Place App** to check live train times.

E-bike Storage

There is a e-bike storage shed located behind 1 and 2 Wellington Place, available for Wellington Place occupiers to use via an authorised access card. To gain access, visit the Wellington Place security office located at 6 Wellington Place reception or call **07841 969 328**.

Motorbike Parking

Motorbike parking is available at Wellington Place. To arrange access, contact your building manager.

Car Sharing

Car sharing offers tons of benefits, including reduced fuel and parking costs. It also means less traffic on the roads, resulting in less congestion and reduced CO2 emissions. Sharing arrangements can be flexible. You don't have to car share every day to still make a positive impact!

Taxis

There are laybys located on Whitehall Road outside Sainsbury's and on Northern Street outside 4 Wellington Place, which can be used for taxi pick-ups and drop-offs. Step-free access is provided from both laybys to all buildings at Wellington Place.
